DECLARATION OF BROCK J. SPECHT IN SUPPORT OF <u>UNOPPOSED</u> MOTION FOR APPOINTMENT OF INDEPENDENT FIDUCIARY

## TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR COUNSEL OF RECORD:

- I, Brock J. Specht, declare and state as follows:
- 1. I am a partner at Nichols Kaster, PLLP ("Nichols Kaster"), and am one of the attorneys of record for Plaintiffs in the above captioned action. I respectfully submit this declaration in support of the Settling Parties' Unopposed Motion for Appointment of Independent Fiduciary.<sup>1</sup>
  - 2. The proposed partial class action settlement agreement (the "Settlement") in this

case provides that Plaintiffs' Counsel shall work cooperatively with a current Plan fiduciary to

seek the selection of a qualified Independent Fiduciary to review the Settlements on behalf of the

Plan. See ECF No. 258-1 at 10 (Settlement § 2.2). Current plan fiduciaries have declined to take

responsibility for selecting an Independent Fiduciary. Accordingly, Plaintiffs' Counsel and the

Brunner Defendants' counsel have selected Fiduciary Counselors, Inc., to serve as Independent

Fiduciary for purposes of this settlement. Plaintiffs' Counsel is familiar with Fiduciary Counselors

from prior engagements and has reviewed Fiduciary Counselors' experience and qualifications

and has determined that they are qualified to serve as Independent Fiduciary in this matter.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** is a true and correct copy of Fiduciary Counselors General Brochure

and Biographies.

3. Fiduciary Counselors has confirmed that it has no conflict that would prevent it

from serving as the Independent Fiduciary in this matter. Declaration of Stephen Caflisch, at ¶ 3.

4. Fiduciary Counselors has indicated that it requires confirmation of its appointment

from the Court or from someone with the authority to act on behalf of the Plan in order to issue its

report. Id. at ¶ 7.
